

OMZ Network Installer Sequence

STEP 1

Uninstall earlier versions of OMZ (copy and paste your records folder somewhere safe first if you wish to keep earlier records)

STEP 2

Click on setup.exe. An install wizard guides you through the installation procedure (If OMZnet 2 doesn't work, try downloading and installing OMZnet. This download works with the Windows 2000 server). The Installer will save the files as a default to the C: Drive and the folder is entitled OMZ.

STEP 3

Create a folder somewhere on your hard drive ready to take the data from the CD. Name the folder OMZ1 for the Year 1 disc and later on OMZ2 for the Year 2 disc if you have this.

STEP 4

Place the Year 1 CD in the drive and open its files either in My Computer or Windows Explorer. Copy and paste the OMZdata folder from the Year 1 CD to the OMZ1 folder you have just created.

STEP 5

Copy the files AU3 and LOGON from the cd_data folder, which is located in the newly installed OMZ folder, to the OMZdata folder you copied onto your hard drive in Step 4.

STEP 6

Run Net_Loc_85.exe (this is in the OMZ folder). Browse to the OMZdata folder and click on it; The entry should look something like this X:\OMZ1\OMZDATA\. Click 'Save new locations' then exit Net_loc.

STEP 7

Run OMZ_Net.exe IN THE OMZ folder and select the OMZ disc you want to run. On the first run it may say it can't find TL.rsc, this will create one on its first use.

If you have saved your Records folder copy it back to the OMZ folder to reinstate earlier records (or copy to a common area and run NewLoc.exe to point the program at the common records location). Repeat Steps 3 to 7 for the Year 2 Disc, however where the instructions say Year 1 or OMZ1, this will refer to Year 2 and OMZ2.
