

This is instruction for Network installation and running for **Francoscope**.

Network Installation and Running of the Program.

The **Francoscope** CD can be used on a network by several students simultaneously. There is no limit to the maximum number of users.

1. Server computer installation:

- Create a folder named '**Francoscope**' on the network server. Make a copy of the whole **Francoscope** CD-ROM to this folder and share this folder to make it accessible for all networked computers.

2. Installation for all clients computers:

- Ensure that you are connected to the network
- Find the shared **Francoscope** folder on the network server.
- Right-click on the **Francoscope** folder and choose 'Map Network Drive...' item from the menu. Assign a drive letter to a network **Francoscope** folder then click OK.
- Open 'My computer' on the desktop, open the **Francoscope** folder and run the Setup.exe application.
- This application will install all required components.

3. To run the program after installation:

- Select the Windows 'Start' menu (usually in the lower left corner of the screen).
- Select 'Programs,' then '**OUP Francoscope**' and click on the '**Francoscope**' icon or use the '**Francoscope**' desktop shortcut to launch the program.
