Rules for Who got wet?

A game for two to four players

You will need:

- ◆ a copy of the baseboard on Sheet 4.8
- ◆ 2 copies of the sentence cards on Sheet 4.9
- ◆ a 1-6 dice
- ◆ a counter for each player

How to play

Cut up the sentence cards into individual squares.

Place the pile face down on the baseboard.

Players take turns to roll the dice and move their counter that number of spaces.

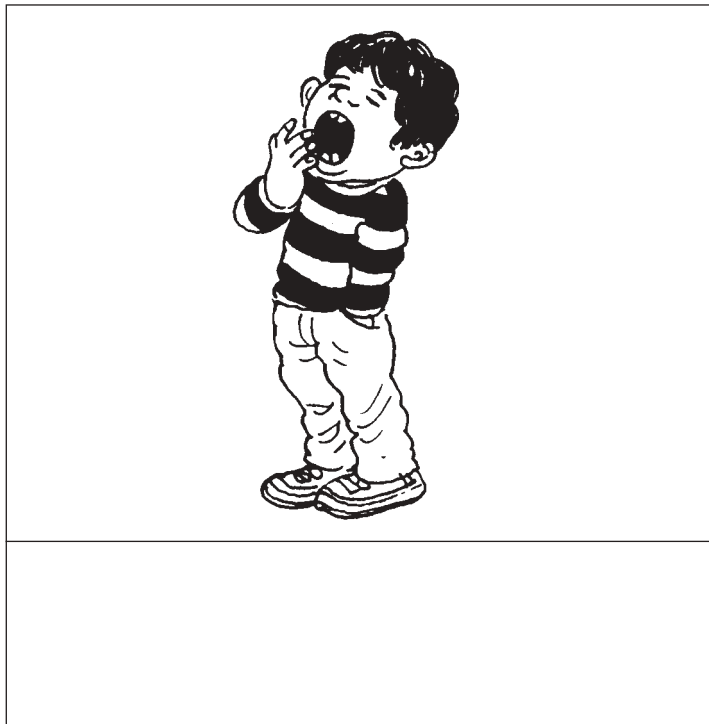
If a player lands on a shaded space she must take a card from the pile.

Continue until all the players have reached the finish.

Each player then reads her cards aloud and counts the number of people who have got wet.

The player with the fewest number of wet characters wins the game.
