Page 152

1. [2003] 2 Cr App Rep 563 refers to the report of *R v. Morrison* reported in volume 2 of the Criminal Appeal Reports for 2003 starting at page 563. Remember that you can find unfamiliar abbreviations online in the Cardiff Index to Legal Abbreviations (<http://www.legalabbrevs.cardiff.ac.uk>) or in one of the printed guides listed on page 144.
2. [2003] Crim LR 801 refers to the report of *R v. Morrison* reported in the Criminal Law Review for 2003 starting at page 801. 2003 is in square brackets because it is necessary to know the year of the report in order to find it. See page 118 if you need reminding of the conventional use of square and round brackets.
3. (2003) 147 SJLB 626 refers to the report of *R v. Morrison* reported in 2003 in volume 147 of the *Solicitors' Journal Law Brief* starting at page 626. Here, 2003 is in round brackets because it is not necessary to know the year of the report in order to find it – the year is included for information only. You could simply look for volume 147 of the *Solicitors' Journal Law Brief*. See page 118 if you need reminding of the conventional use of square and round brackets.
